

Platte County School District #2 requests an exception to the public health requirements in the Twenty-Sixth Continuation of Statewide Public Health Order #1. Specifically, Platte County School District #2 requests to be exempt from the following provisions of Statewide Public Health Order #1: Paragraph 5, provisions a through f. This exemption would go into effect May 22, 2021.


Platte County School District #2 is requesting this exception because the outbreak metrics indicate that transmission levels in Platte County are low. Specifically, Platte County has been in the "Green Zone" according to WDH outbreak metrics for at least the last two weeks. Platte County currently has 3 active cases. During the previous 14 days, the rate of newly reported laboratory-confirmed cases in Platte County is 48 per 100,000 population and the test positivity rate is 4.9%.


Platte County School District #2 will continue to follow isolation and quarantine and other recommendations from public health officials. If transmission levels in Platte County increase, or an outbreak occurs within the school, this exception request may be revoked by the County or State Health Officer. Platte County School District #2 is prepared to accommodate students and staff who choose not to attend school without public health precautions as well as students and staff who need to undergo isolation and quarantine.
