

## **BOARD TO PUBLIC**

April 12, 2022

On April 11, 2022, the Board of Trustees of Platte County School District #2 opened their Regular Meeting at 7:00 PM. This report covers the major items of business at this meeting. In addition, you are given a listing of topics, which will come up for discussion or action at future Board meetings.

1. Public Comment – None

2. **Mr. Flaherty - Facilities**

- ❖ Mr. Flaherty informed the trustees that he should have freezer bids for the trustees to consider at the May board meeting. The Bid opening is scheduled for May 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM.
- ❖ The Call for bids will go out this week for the Elementary rooftop RTU replacement.
- ❖ When the handicap bus is delivered to Creative bus sales, they will install the sanitizing and filtration systems. It is hoped that the district can take ownership in late June.
- ❖ Mr. Flaherty and Mr. Schuldies will be meeting with the landscapers on Tuesday to look into the possibility of getting rid of grassy areas near the buildings. By getting the grass away from the building it would help to get the water away from the foundations and to help conserve and cut some of the water costs.

3. **Mrs. Sisson – K-12 Principal**

- ❖ Mrs. Sisson reported that K-12 enrollment is at 233.
- ❖ The Math Curriculum Team met last week and they will present a recommendation to the board at the May board meeting.
- ❖ The House Basketball Tournament last month went well and everyone seemed to have a good time.
- ❖ Doug Horton's Power Lifting meet went well last month and it is hoped that it will continue next year.
- ❖ The ACT Test will be administered on April 12<sup>th</sup> at the First State Bank conference room.
- ❖ Parent Teacher Conferences were held this evening from 4:00 – 7:00 PM and again tomorrow evening at the same time.
- ❖ Mrs. Green will be taking her students to the Art Symposium in Casper.
- ❖ The Junior/Senior Prom will be held on May 7<sup>th</sup>, Honors Night is tentatively scheduled for May 2<sup>nd</sup> and Lions Club Scholarship Night is scheduled for May 4<sup>th</sup>.

4. **Mr. Beard – District**

- ❖ Mr. Beard informed the trustees that the new security system will be installed next week.
- ❖ The district is receiving bids on video boards that will be installed in the gyms.
- ❖ Interactive TVs have been installed in the classrooms.
- ❖ Mr. Beard thanked the staff and students for a smooth, busy winter and welcomed spring and warmer weather.
- ❖ Interviews have been taking place to fill vacancies for the 2022-2023 school year.

Title IV (Student Support), Title II (Teacher Quality), Title IIA (At-Risk), Lunch Program, Title V (Innovative), Title III (ESL), Title VIB (Flow through Special Ed), ESSER II and III; asked Superintendent Beard to reach out to Shoshoni, Fremont School District #24 regarding their Staff Morale/School Climate Survey; approved the hiring of Amy Hollon as High School English for the 2022-2023 school year; approved the in-house transfers for the 2022-2023 school year as follows: Tesha Frederick – Elementary Interventionist; Stephanie Smith and Kyla Pierce to Title; accepted the resignation from Taylor Dick as PE and Coach effective at the end of the 2021-2022 school year and thanked him for his time and dedication to PCSD#2; approved the certified staff rehire list for 2022-2023 as presented.
