

BOARD TO PUBLIC

June 14, 2022

On June 13, 2022, the Board of Trustees of Platte County School District #2 opened their Regular Meeting at 7:00 PM. This report covers the major items of business at this meeting. In addition, you are given a listing of topics, which will come up for discussion or action at future Board meetings.

1. Staff Recognition – The Board recognized Reva Falen, Para Educator, as the Classified Employee of the year award. Ms. Falen was not present, but the Board thanked her for her hard work and dedication to PCSD#2.
2. Public Comment – Michelle Fross was present and expressed her concerns as to why PCSD#2 was losing so many staff members. The Board reassured her that they are working on a 360 plan to try and remedy the issue.
3. Parks and Rec – Lori Ibarra was present with dance coach Heather Walker and presented her Annual Report to the Board of Trustees. Mrs. Ibarra recapped some of the activities that were held over the past year through her office. She also asked the board to consider being the Cheer Squad’s sponsor, which would allow the cheer team to participate in competitions across the state and beyond. The Trustees thought that might be a possibility in the future and encouraged Mrs. Ibarra to keep them informed.
4. **Mr. Flaherty - Facilities**
 - ❖ Mr. Flaherty informed the trustees that his staff is now working 10 hour days and have been busy getting things done. His staff will attend a custodial training on June 22 & 23.
 - ❖ Mr. Flaherty gave the trustees an update on the handicap bus from Creative bus sales, which has arrived at the facility where the filtration is being installed. The bus should arrive in the district in the near future.
 - ❖ Norb Olind is interested in doing some of the construction work that needs to be done in district. Dennis will keep the board up to date on the progress.
 - ❖ The roof re-coating has been completed. Next Phase in the re-coating schedule will be the elementary school.
 - ❖ Carpet replacement will begin in the near future. There will be 6-7 classrooms and the Library.
 - ❖ Security people will be in the building soon.
 - ❖ The Bus barn fence is installed and the operator will be installed before school begins in the fall.
 - ❖ Dennis will be moving the sprinklers in front of the elementary and district office away from the wall to help with the eroding and other issues it is causing.
5. **Mr. Beard – District**
 - ❖ The school year ended with 230 K-12 students enrolled and 2022 Graduation went well.
 - ❖ The K-12 Field Day was successful. The students all seemed to have a good time.
 - ❖ Open gym is being offered on Monday through Thursday from 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM.
 - ❖ There are several things going on over the summer: Landscaping, Construction, Deep Cleaning. Mr. Beard thanked the custodial staff for their hard work and dedication.

7. Board Comments – Sarah Seyfang thanked staff for all their hard work this year. Blaine Ayers thanked staff for all that they do and looking forward to year of transition. Shawna Reichert thanked staff for all their hard work this past year and for helping the District get through this transition.
