

BOARD TO THE PUBLIC

On October 10, 2022, the Board of Trustees of Platte County School District #2 opened their Regular Meeting at 7:00 PM. This report covers the major items of business at this meeting. In addition, you are given a listing of topics, which will come up for discussion or action at future Board meetings.

1. Public Comment – There were no public comments.
2. Student/Staff Recognition - Mrs. Mills was present with some of the Junior High students who attended the FCCLA Conference this month. They shared their experiences during the conference and were glad they were able to attend. The Tech Math Class was present and shared some of what they were doing in class this year. Their goal is to have 2 large Viking statues made and placed by the end of the school year.
3. Reports
 - a. **Mr. Flaherty – Facilities**
 - ❖ The Handicap vehicle is in district and will be used in the near future.
 - ❖ The new outside benches have arrived and are being installed.
 - ❖ The rooftop units are in production. Supply issues seem to be what is causing the delay. The company is waiting for the DX coils.
 - ❖ The State Contractor was in district for 3 days doing the building assessments. Once Mr. Flaherty receives the report he will share the findings with the board.
 - ❖ The Annual Fire Alarm inspection was done on Oct 6th by Rocky Mountain Fire Systems.
 - ❖ Mr. Flaherty is starting the process of starting up the building heat. The boilers are the last thing to be checked and fired.
 - ❖ Mr. Flaherty provided copies of the Semi-Annual Internal Safety Inspection.
 - b. **Mrs. Sisson – Principal**
 - ❖ Mrs. Sisson shared that the K-12 enrollment is 209.
 - ❖ The Coffee with Principals was attended by some staff but no one from the outside community attended.
 - ❖ There were 14 staff members that attended the Round Table Discussion.
 - ❖ Screenagers was presented to grades 5-12 on Oct 7th in the East gym.
 - ❖ K-6 Math Team attended a training and are working on the School Improvement Plans, which is due on Nov 1st.
 - ❖ The Lockdown Drill, which was held Sept 28th, went well. Another one is scheduled for Oct. 11th.
 - ❖ Career Fairs were attended by the 11th and 12th grade classes last week.
 - ❖ There were 3 students who were selected for All District Choir. Those students were: Micah Hebbert, Marcus Swingholm, and Caleb Christensen.
 - ❖ There will be a school board candidate forum at 6:00 PM on Oct. 11th at the VFW.
 - ❖ The National Honor Society Induction Dinner will be held on Oct. 18th at 6:30 PM.
 - ❖ The After School Theatre Club is going strong and a performance will be held in December.
 - ❖ Power Hour for grades K-5 is going strong.
 - ❖ The 4th Grade classes went on a field trip to the James C. Hageman Research Center outside of Lingle to participate in Taters for Tots on September 29th.
 - c. **Mr. Beard – District**

 - ❖ Mr. Beard shared with the trustees that with the Cowboy Challenge Program closing the doors PCSD#2 lost funds tied to the District's IV Grant Monies.
 - ❖ The Veterans' Program will be held on November 11th at 9:00 AM.
 - ❖ Mr. Beard thanked the students and staff for all they do for PCSD#2.
