

October 10, 2017

The Board of Trustees of Platte County School District #2 held a work session at 6:30 PM to review policy and went into their regular meeting at 7:00 PM. This report covers the major items of business at this meeting. In addition you are given a listing of topics, which will come up for discussion or action at future Board meetings.

1. Staff and Student Recognition

Mr. Suppes recognized 2 students from each class 1st-6th grade for “Viking Pride In The Classroom” . Those students were: 1st Grade – Arianna Thompson and Tanner Offe; 2nd Grade – Ally Ann Jaramillo and Linkon Rotz; 3rd Grade - Dymond Jaramillo and Marshall Roby; 4th Grade – Karli Weinkauff and Hanna Harms; 5th Grade – Liberty Whitebird and Jordan Atwood; 6th Grade – Lily Tillman and Karson Kite. The Guernsey Sunrise Football Team and their coaches Mr. Curtis Cook and Mr. Nathan Reinhart received the Wyoming High School Athletic Sportsman Award and Garrett Oneyear received the WHSA Sportsman Conduct Individual Award. PCSD#2 also recognized Stacia Cook and Sarah VanNatter as district staff who “Go the Extra Mile” for the students and the district.

2. **Mrs. Sisson - Data**

Liesl Sisson was present and gave the trustees an oral report on the Professional Development that was held earlier on Monday, October 9. She said the workshop from 7:45 AM to 12:15 PM were group presentations given by staff over the different Chapters from the “Project CRISS” – Creating Independent Student Owned Strategies. In the afternoon 8 different Mini Tech Work Sessions were held throughout the building. The next Professional Development Day is scheduled in January. The Focus Fridays have gone well. Friday, October 13th Maureen Ryff will be in the building observing and working with staff.

3. **Dennis Flaherty – Maintenance/Transportation Report**

Mr. Flaherty presented his Semi-Annual Internal Safety Inspection Report. Some of Mr. Flaherty’s recommendations included: Bus Garage lighting and security upgrade; requested a second AED for the elementary side of the school; new swing set parts for the playground have been ordered. He also noted that all company padlocks have been replaced and that the boiler room floor was recoated this past summer. Mr. Flaherty also did an asbestos check and there were no changes noted.

4. **Mr. Suppes – K-12 Principal**

- ❖ Mr. Suppes reported there were 244 students DK-12th grade enrolled. There will be a new Kindergartner enrolled on Tuesday so total count will be 245.
- ❖ Mr. Suppes thanked staff for the successful professional development day on October 10th.
- ❖ Mr. Suppes attended a School Safety Conference in Casper on October 3 and October 11 & 12 he will be attending a Jan Hoegh training in Casper with several staff members. On October 18 he will be holding a Principal’s Advisory Meeting to meet with any staff that have questions or concerns.
- ❖ Mr. Suppes shared the Community Report with the Trustees, which will be going out to the community in the near future.

5. **Mr. Beard – District**
