NWEA MAPPS

NWEA MAPPS testing is done as our district level assessment system as required by the state of Wyoming. All data is shared with parents in the areas of Reading, English Language Arts, Math and Science. This test is administered at least twice a year and some times three times in a school year. This data serves as a data point for making decisions for students.

Fall NWEA MAPPS: 27-31 August

Winter NWEA MAPPS: Jan. 15-Feb. 8

Spring NWEA MAPPS: April 15-May 10

DIBELS Reading Test:

The Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS) are a set of procedures and measures for assessing the acquisition of early literacy skills from kindergarten through sixth grade. They are designed to be short (one minute) fluency measures used to regularly monitor the development of early literacy and early reading skills.

DIBELS are comprised of seven measures to function as indicators of phonemic awareness, alphabetic principle, accuracy and fluency with connected text, reading comprehension, and vocabulary. DIBELS were designed for use in identifying children experiencing difficulty in acquisition of basic early literacy skills in order to provide support early and prevent the occurrence of later reading difficulties.

DIBELS testing is done three times a year in the Fall, Winter and Spring for all students DK-6th grade. Dibels is also used as a progress monitoring tool for students receiving Title 1 Interventions.

DIBELS Math Test:

DIBELS® Math is comprised of measures of early numeracy, computation, and problem solving that function as indicators of the essential skills that every child must master in order to become proficient in mathematics. The measures can be used to quickly and efficiently monitor the development of mathematics skills. DIBELS Math is designed for use in identifying children experiencing difficulty in the acquisition of basic mathematics skills, in order to provide support early and prevent the occurrence of later mathematics difficulties.

DIBELS testing is done three times a year in the Fall, Winter and Spring for all students DK-6th grade. DIBELS is also used as a progress monitoring tool for students receiving Title 1 Interventions.

STAR Reading and STAR Math:

The STAR assessments are often used to screen students for their reading and math achievement levels. STAR Reading and STAR Math™ assessments help determine reading and math achievement levels in order to place students into the Accelerated Reader™ and Accelerated Math™ programs. STAR Early Literacy assessments help educators monitor students' growing literacy skills and students' progress toward becoming independent readers. STAR Reading Spanish assessments help educators working in bilingual and dual-language programs to inform instruction, match students to books, and monitor Spanish reading growth. In English-only programs,

educators can use STAR Reading Spanish to determine the Spanish reading level of incoming English language learner students to help inform instruction. STAR™ assessments can also be used to monitor student growth throughout the year, to estimate students' understanding of state standards, and predict students' performance on the state test. In addition, STAR can help teachers determine appropriate instructional levels and skills that students are ready to learn. Students will STAR test in the classroom as directed by the classroom teacher. Reports are available upon request, and students will bring home STAR results after most tests.
