When picking up students after school, please use the designated crosswalk area by the crosswalk sign. Also, please wait to cross the street with your child until instructed to by a Staff Member.

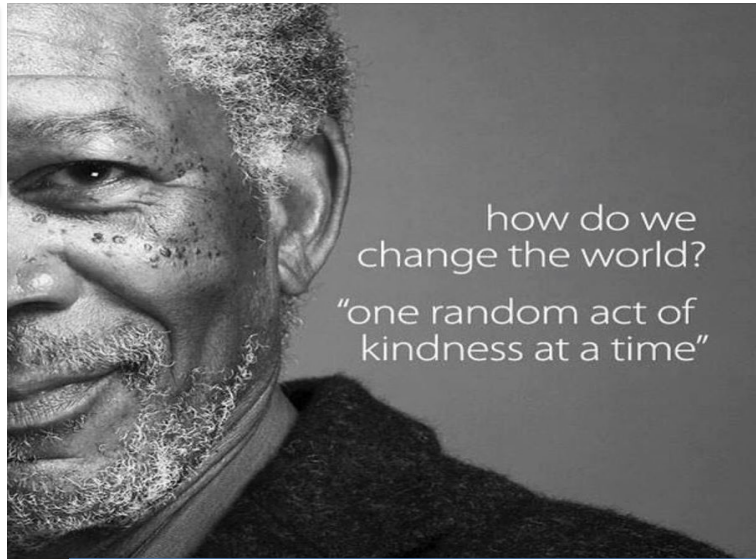
If you are driving through the pick-up zone, please don't stop and have your child come to the car but drive through and pull into an open spot.
