

November 13, 2018

On November 12, 2018 the Board of Trustees of Platte County School District #2 held a work session at 6:45 PM to review policy and went into their regular meeting at 7:00 PM. This report covers the major items of business at this meeting. In addition you are given a listing of topics, which will come up for discussion or action at future board meetings.

#### 1. Staff and Student Recognition

Mr. Suppes recognized at least 2 students from each class Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade for “Viking Pride In The Classroom” award. Those students were: Kindergarten – Carlos Gonzalez, Amiliana Ibarra and Gracie Dockter; 1<sup>st</sup> Grade - Cruz Dimas-Ramirez, Lacie Nyquist and Titus Cooper; 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade – Caleb Dawson; 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade – Karlie Marshall, Briar Martinez and Adam Bandalos; 4<sup>th</sup> Grade – Jayden Wagner; 5<sup>th</sup> Grade – Mrs. Cain substitute 5<sup>th</sup> grade teacher nominated Korbin Weinkauf and Chase Kelley. Mr. Faber nominated Ryan Kelly and Alyssa Nyquist; 6<sup>th</sup> Grade – Nathan Cisneros and Lillyan Morales. #### 3. **Mr. Suppes – K-12 Principal**

- ❖ Mr. Suppes reported there were 256 students enrolled DK-12 at this time.
- ❖ Testing has been complete until December. Diagnostic ACT Testing for the Juniors & Seniors were given. National ACT Test Day is Dec 8<sup>th</sup>.

#### 4. **Mr. Beard – District**

- ❖ Mr. Beard reminded the board of the WSBA Annual Conference, which is schedule for November 14-16 in Casper. Leaving time was discussed.
- ❖ Superintendent Beard reminded the board about the Staff Breakfast the morning of November 13.
- ❖ The Trustees were given the WSBA Resolutions to review and discuss. Neil Waring will be the voting member for the district at the WSBA Conference.
- ❖ Christmas Reception Plans were discussed. The District has reserved VFW for December 7<sup>th</sup>. RSVPs are due to Rhonda by November 16<sup>th</sup>.
- ❖ Mr. Beard shared information regarding a bus stop sign camera and the process.
- ❖ Superintendent Beard presented a plaque to Board Members Angela Jones and Sarah Sellars and thanked them for their time served on the PCSD#2 Board of Trustees.

The Board of Trustees took the following actions at their meeting; approved Minutes of the October 8, 2018 Board Meeting; approved the financial statements and the payment of the bills; approved on 2<sup>nd</sup> and final reading Board Policies KBDA – Parent and Family Engagement, GCCA-R Professional Staff Leaves and Absences-Short Term Leaves with minor adjustments,

and GBJ – Personal Records and Files, Data Backup and Restore and Technology Disposal. Coding will be determined. The continuation of early notice incentive plan was approved if notified by Dec 15<sup>th</sup>. The Longevity Award was tabled until January 2019. Board member Schiele gave a report on Tri-City Park & Recreation. Wyoming Cowboy Challenge approached PCSD#2 to host 2 separate classes twice a year. This would include feeding these students 3 meals a day, 7 days a week. The board felt this would not be feasible considering the staffing and other concerns voiced from board members. The board felt this would not be a good fit for the District. Chairperson Anderson and Waring thanked Sarah Sellars and Angela Jones for their time spent on the board and Board member Sellars thanked the board for her time spent on the board.
