On September 14, 2020, the Board of Trustees of Platte County School District #2 held a work session at 6:45 PM to review policy and went into their regular meeting at 7:00 PM. This report covers the major items of business at this meeting. In addition, you are given a listing of topics, which will come up for discussion or action at future board meetings.

1. Public Comment – There was no public comment.
2. VFW Presentation – Three gentlemen from the Guernsey VFW was present and presented Stacia Cook the State Wide Elementary Teacher of the Year award. They also presented Superintendent Beard and the PCSD#2 Board of Education a Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States 2019-2020 Smart/Maher VFW National Citizenship Education Teacher Award Elementary School Level that was awarded to Stacia Cook as being selected as the state teacher winner.
3. **Mrs. Sisson - DK-12 Principal**
 - ❖ Mrs. Sisson informed the trustees that there are 244 students Kindergarten through 12th grade. There are 12 students who are partaking in the PCSD#2 Virtual school in which the Edgenuity Platform is being used.
 - ❖ School has been in session for 18 days with students. Temperature checks are going well.
 - ❖ New staff orientation went well under the mentor ship of Mrs. Nancy Garner.
 - ❖ CPI Training is scheduled for the next Professional Development on September 25th.
 - ❖ Seniors were recognized Friday and Saturday, September 11 and 12 at the sporting events.
4. **Mrs. Pare – DK-12 Assistant Principal**
 - ❖ Mrs. Pare informed the Board of Trustees how attendance is being monitored and when letters will go out regarding attendance concerns.
5. **Mr. Beard – District**
 - ❖ Mr. Beard let the trustees know that Smart Start Back To School Plan is being utilized as we open the district's doors for the 2020-2021 School Year.
 - ❖ Superintendent Beard has been in touch with other Superintendents around the state on a weekly basis and reassured the trustees that PCSD#2 staff and students are doing an outstanding job. He complimented the staff on their understanding and flexibility.
 - ❖ Beginning September 8th all K-12 students will eat free through Dec 31st thanks to a waiver granted to continue the summer feeding programs. Breakfast is currently being served in the classrooms in individual containers and is working out well.
 - ❖ It has not been determined if the Wyoming School Board Association Annual Conference will be live or via ZOOM. Updates will be given in the near future.
6. The Board of Trustees took the following actions at their meeting; approved the August 10 2020 Minutes; approved home school packets from 8 families; approved the financial statements as presented; approved the payment of the bills; approved revision to board policies with changes ACA Sexual Discrimination/Harassment, AC-

Nondiscrimination, AC-E Nondiscrimination/Harassment Complaint Procedure, ACA-E-2 Sexual Discrimination/Harassment Complaint Form, and ACE-Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act And Americans With Disabilities Act on 2nd and final reading; approved certified substitute pay to \$150.00 a day; approved extra duty contracts for Kaitlyn Koepp, JH Volleyball, Stephanie Smith, JH Basketball, Lena Swingholm, LEGO League, and Cheyenne Stork, Special Ed Para.

7. Board Comment – Board member Waring noted that one good thing that has come to the district due to the COVID is the ability and learning of the use of ZOOM and allowing board members, who cannot be in house for meetings, to do it remotely.
