RTI is part of the Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) Components of MTSS include:

- Response to Intervention (RTI)
- Positive Behavior Interventions
- Professional Development
- Technology Tools
- General/Special Education Teamwork
- Parental Action
- School/Community Collaboration
- Additional Resources

While MTSS focuses on all students, the target audience of RTI are the students who are at risk of falling behind in academics, or may need to be evaluated for special education services.

Parents will be notified if the team feels further testing is needed.

Parents are encouraged to communicate with the classroom teacher and/or RTI team to inquire about their child's status in the RTI process.




RTI Includes:

- Quality instruction and behavior support in the classroom
- School-wide screening to determine the needs of students
- Different tiers of interventions matched to the needs of students
- A team approach to solving problems and monitoring interventions.
- Systems to check student progress
- Intervention plans created for students
- Reviewing intervention plans regularly using student data
- Parent involvement
- Maintaining critical timelines for assessment and evaluations


What is Response to Intervention?

We at Guernsey-Sunrise Elementary want all students to be successful. Our school has adopted the Response to Intervention (RTI) process to better meet the needs of all our students. RTI is a multi-tiered system of educational supports that increase the levels of interventions being used to support students based on their individual learning needs. The goal of RTI is to prevent academic and behavior problems, and to intervene as early as possible so that each student can receive an appropriate education.



Essential Components of RTI

- RTI team to provide leadership and promote collaborative teaming with staff
- Ongoing assessment and data based decision making
- Evidence based curriculum, intervention, and instructional practice
- Fidelity of implementation
- Ongoing training and professional development
- Community and family involvement
