

CO-CURRICULAR AND INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

The Board believes that student activities are a vital part of the total educational program and should be used as a means of developing wholesome attitudes and good human relations, as well as knowledge and skills.

Therefore, the district will provide a program of co-curricular and interscholastic activities geared to the age, interest, and ability level of students.

The establishments, as well as the elimination of these programs, shall require approval by the Board.

Activities shall be conducted in keeping with the following guidelines:

1. Activity offerings shall be of sufficient variety and number to meet the wide range of interests of students.
2. All participation shall be voluntary and will be considered a privilege, not a right.
3. Most activities should be an outgrowth of curricular activities.
4. All activities will be supervised; all organizations, clubs and groups will have a faculty advisor.
5. Participation by any student organization, club, team, etc., in Wyoming interscholastic events, contests, games, etc., shall require the approval of the High School Principal.
6. Participation by any student organization, club, team, etc., in any event, contest, game etc., outside the State of Wyoming shall require advanced approval of the Principal.

Approval by the Board of Trustees shall be obtained only when required by insurance.
