

## INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

The Board of Trustees and Administration believe that all students benefit from the experiences made possible by participation in school sports. Learning how to deal with success and failure, developing self-discipline, experiencing the successes of teamwork, developing physical skills, developing sportsmanship, and finding enjoyment in physical activity are some of the benefits which come from these programs.

Establishment of interscholastic sports programs will require initial Board approval and shall operate under the general supervision of the Principal. Qualified personnel will be assigned to supervise and coach the various sports as needed.

Membership in the Wyoming High School Activities Association will be subject to the approval of the Board.

The Superintendent or his designee will serve as the district's voting representative at all meetings of the athletic associations or conferences in which the district maintains membership.

Eligibility of students to participate in athletic programs will be determined in accordance with regulations of the WHSAA and those developed by Platte County School District #2.
