

STUDENT PROGRESS REPORTS TO PARENTS

The Board believes that it is essential for parents to be kept fully informed of their children's progress in school.

Reports shall be provided to parents through out the academic year. Supplementary reports will be required for students in danger of failure. Notes of praise, phone calls, emails or letters noting outstanding achievement will be sent whenever a teacher or school official feels a student deserves recognition.

Parent-teacher conferences will be used as an integral part of the reporting system. Each school will hold conferences once each semester. They are to be scheduled as nearly following the end of the first quarters as is practical and during or after the end of the third quarter.

The principal, along with the staff, will be responsible for making necessary conference arrangements.

The teacher shall be responsible for evaluating the pupil's work and the judgment of the teacher shall be respected in grading the work of the pupil. When required the teacher shall provide sufficient evidence to justify grades given.
